PUBLIC HEARING – BUDGET & WARRANT ARTICLES

Russell opened the public hearing at 6:00 p.m. Articles were explained and he announced the candidates running in the municipal election. Donald MacKenzie, who is running for a school board seat, was present at the meeting. Resident, Rusty Gagnon, asked if the General Assistance recipients could be required to do some work fare for the benefits they receive. Russell explained that there is no such way to allow this due to the town's insurance and the potential liability to the town. No other questions were asked, Russell closed the meeting by informing that this years budget resulted in a 2% increase over last years figures and announced that there was another public hearing Tuesday March 15th, 2011. Public Hearing closed at 6:15 pm.
